



Fleeter Wood Wind Farm Project Supply Opportunities Seminar

Subject to planning approval, Novera Energy is planning to construct a wind farm between Dearham, Dovenby and Tallentire in West Cumbria, to be known as Fleeter Wood Wind Farm. The construction, which will include wind turbines, access tracks, electrical control building, meteorological mast and associated works, would be envisaged to start in 2009.

The project will provide opportunities for local businesses to get involved in the developing industry of renewable energy. The developers and the main project contractors will be looking for support from suppliers and subcontractors in a wide range of activities, during the construction phase and during the 25-year operational life of the project.

Novera Energy, Envirolink Northwest and West Cumbria Development Agency will be hosting an event on Friday 29th February, for suppliers and subcontractors to learn about the project and potential opportunities. After the formal presentations there will be opportunities for suppliers to meet with representatives of the developers and also with the business support organisations.
